Bear Valley Rescue (BVR)

BVR rescues horses that would otherwise go to slaughter. People think that slaughtered horses are old and sick; some are. But the majority are young horses that never had a chance at life, or beloved pets, or winners in their day that got dumped when they could no longer perform. BVR also takes care of horses from SPCA seizures, owner surrenders, abuse and starvation situations, etc. BVR tries to find them lifelong, loving homes. Any horses that can't or aren't adopted are cared for at BVR till the end. BVR also rescues other animals (cows, goats...) in trouble.
